

Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council Resilience Committee Regular Meeting April 19, 2021 MINUTES – Approved by the Committee on June 2, 2021

I. <u>WELCOMING REMARKS</u>

A. Call to Order

A duly noticed meeting of the Resilience Committee of the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council ("GWNC") was held on Monday, April 19, 2021, via Zoom, Webinar ID 889 6831 9278.
