

#### Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council ("GWNC") Environmental & Sustainability Committee Meeting Minutes, Tuesday, April 5, 2022 Approved May 7, 2022

A. Review and Adoption of December 7, 2021 Minutes.

**MOTION** (by Cathy Roberts, seconded by Bindhu Varghese): That the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council Environmental & Sustainability Committee recommends that the GWNC Board support holding a webinar on Thursday, June 23 from 7:30-8:00 p.m. exploring available tools, resources, and rebates for household items and appliances that reduce impacts on climate change and allocate \$150 for promotion.

MOTION PASSED with five in favor; zero opposed; zero abstained.

#### V. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u> (Discussion and Possible Action)

A. Discussion of possible Community Impact Statements regarding decarbonization in support of the LA Green New Deal - CF21-1463 and CF22-0151

**MOTION** (by Cathy Roberts, seconded by Juan Portillo): That the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council Environmental & Sustainability Committee recommends that the GWNC Board support filing a CIS and sending a letter in support of Council File 21-1463 in requiring the Climate Emergency Mobilization Office and other city entities to conduct public engagement when developing decarbonization programs.

MOTION PASSED with four in favor; zero opposed; zero abstained.

**MOTION** (by Cathy Roberts, seconded by Juan Portillo): That the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council Environmental & Sustainability Committee recommends that the GWNC Board support filing a CIS in support of Council File 22-0151 and attaching a letter that reads: "Whereas zero-emission buildings help the environment, save money, and improve health and; whereas the City of Los Angeles should come up with a sensible plan to require new buildings to have zero emissions in a way that is fair to both renters and owners; therefore, the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council supports investigating a plan for new developments to be carbon neutral."

MOTION PASSED with four in favor; zero opposed; zero abstained.
